

Barberton Area Community Ministries (BACM) will again be offering a free kids summer lunch program at Decker Park pavilion (West Fifth between Brady and Norton Avenues near Head Start and Dairy Queen).

All children in Barberton Public School District are welcome. Pre-schoolers may attend, but must be able to feed themselves and sit on a picnic bench.

Program begins June 16<sup>th</sup> and ends August 15<sup>th</sup>. Meals are available Monday through Friday each week, except July 4<sup>th</sup>. Estimated serving time 11:30 am (permanent start time will be determined after first week). All meals must be eaten on site.

Meals include a sandwich, juice or fruit, milk, and snack (cookies or chips usually). Children will be asked to complete a permission slip with emergency contact and special health needs information on it for their own safety.

Children do not need to attend all sessions or all weeks. Parent, grandparents, or babysitters are welcome to attend, but cannot receive food. This program can really help families with children save on their summer grocery budget. BACM hopes to have fun activities to accompany the lunch program.
